SCHOOL FEES 2019

Dear Parents,

It is the time of year that the College's Board reviews the finances for the forthcoming year. We are mindful of the need to keep fee increases to an absolute minimum, but equally, aware of increasing costs. Our commitment to maintaining and improving the standard of education we offer, rewarding and retaining staff, place fiscal demands on the successful management of our beloved Unity College.

The Board has therefore decided to only increase the school fees for 2019 by 7%.

Below is the 2019 School fee structure:

In terms of the school finance policy and your signed Enrolment Contract with the school, fees are payable in advance on the first day of the school year. School fees may be paid in 11 monthly instalments on condition that a compulsory debit order is signed and submitted to our finance department. **A 5% discount will be offered if annual school fees are paid in full by 31 January 2019.**

We reserve the right to hand defaulters over to our attorneys for collection.
